The City Council of the City of Brady, Texas met in a Work Session Meeting on Tuesday May 2, 2023 at 5:00 p.m. with Mayor Pro Tem Huffman presiding. Council took a brief recess at 5:20 p.m. and resumed at 5:24 p.m.


Jeff Bedwell said he thinks the City should sell GRW.

Erin Corbell said she asked Mr. Bedwell to attend the meeting to give his opinion on the lake properties. A year ago we were looking at \$1 million to put in water. Bedwell handed out data to Council and then reviewed.

Council Member Elliston asked about getting an appraisal to get fair market value. Erin said if we break it up into acreage, we have to develop it. Corbell also said in the airport master plan, there is discussion about acquiring more land to expand the runway, and it was suggested to trade the land. Council Member Sutton said the reason the airport runways needed to be lengthened is because there are airplanes that can't land here because they don't have enough room. Council Member Huffman said those land owners are not going to sell. Attorney Hicks said we will look at deed restrictions and bring back for consideration. Corbell will obtain appraisals for the 480 acres on the South side and for G. Rollie White.
