

CODE OF ORDINANCES



2.08.006 Restriction on Keeping Fowl.

No person shall keep more than six (6) female fowl on a property up to one acre: (1) Fowl shall be kept in a coop behind a solid fenced backyard; (2) The premises where the fowl are kept shall not be unsanitary; and (3) The premises where the fowl are kept shall not be a public nuisance as determined by a proceeding in municipal court initiated by the issuance of a citation or summons. (Ordinance 1243 adopted 2/6/18)

2.08.007 Keeping Roosters Prohibited

No person shall keep within the city any male chickens/roosters. Male chickens/roosters existing as of January 1, 2018 are grandfathered. No additional male chickens/roosters are allowed to remain within the city.



Pets traveling with you? Dog waste can contribute to bacterial pollution in urban watersheds. Take bags with you to collect your pet's waste. Deposit it in a trash can or dump it in the toilet (without the bag). Never throw pet waste into a storm drain or waterway.
