The City Council of the City of Brady, Texas met in a Work Session Meeting on Tuesday, March 17, 2020 at the City of Brady Municipal Court Building located at 207 S. Elm Street, Brady, Texas with Mayor Tony Groves presiding. Council Members present were Missi Davis, Rey Garza, Jay May, and Jane Huffman. City staff present were City Manager Dennis Jobe, Public Works Director Steve Miller, Finance Director Lisa Remini, Community Services Manager Erin Corbell, Electric Superintendent Joe Solis, Fire Chief Lloyd Perrin, and City Secretary Tina Keys. Also in attendance were Jackie Behrens, Jason Behrens, Mike Probst, Cameron Anderson and James Stewart.

1. CALL TO ORDER, ROLL CALL & CERTIFICATION OF A QUORUM

Mayor Groves called the meeting to order at 4:10 p.m. Council quorum was certified.

2. Discussion Regarding

- a. Friends of G. Rollie White and G. Rollie White complex Improvements / Lease Agreement / Flat Track Racing – Jackie Behrens, Jason Behrens, Mike Probst and Cameron Anderson discussed status of the Friends of G. Rollie White Foundation. Dennis Jobe and Erin Corbell informed them about the flat track racing and expressed the necessity for everyone to be on the same page.
- b. Electric outages – City Manager Jobe discussed the issue with the old line on Walnut Street and said this line is one of the lines that will be replaced. He went on to inform council that the City ordered equipment which will determine location of surges, but it is backordered. Council Member Davis asked about condition of lines and transformers. Joe Solis, Electric Superintendent, said we typically replace appx 50 transformers per year
- c. Fire Station upgrades / Building – Dennis Jobe discussed the many issues existing at the current time. Council Member Davis asked if there are any facilities that we can temporarily use. Fire Chief Perrin said the ambulances need to have shore lines 24 hours a day and have to be kept out of the elements. Other issues are sleeping quarters and showers.

3. Adjournment

There being no further business, the Mayor adjourned the meeting at 5:22 p.m.
