CITY OF BRADY

The City Council of the City of Brady, Texas met in a Special Session on Monday, March 30, 2020 with Mayor Tony Groves presiding. Due to COVID 19 and a proclamation issued by the Office of the Governor on March 16, 2020, the meeting was held via teleconference and citizens were invited to participate by dialing into a toll free phone number and entering an access code. Council Members present were Missi Davis, Rey Garza, Jay May, Jane Huffman and Jeffrey Sutton. City staff present were City Manager Dennis Jobe, Public Works Director Steve Miller, Finance Director Lisa Remini, Community Services Manager Erin Corbell, and City Attorney Sarah Griffin.

1. CALL TO ORDER, ROLL CALL & CERTIFICATION OF A QUORUM

Mayor Groves called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Council quorum was certified.

2. INVOCATION

Council Member Jay May gave the invocation.

3. PUBLIC COMMENTS

The Public was invited to make comments by emailing City Manager Dennis Jobe prior to the meeting. There were no comments.

4. INDIVIDUAL CONCERNS

Mayor Groves closed the regular session at 6:04 p.m. to go into Executive Session to discuss the following. Executive Session was opened at 6:13 p.m.

Persons who were listening were instructed to call back at 6:45 when regular session resumed.

Executive session pursuant to Texas Government Code, Section 551.071 to seek advice from City's attorney regarding possible actions in relation to COVID-19 Emergency Declaration

Executive Session was closed at 6:48 p.m.

- A. Discuss, consider and take action on continuation, extension, or revocation of Declaration of Public Health Emergency as declared by Mayor Groves on March 25, 2020.
- B. Discuss, consider and take action on Ordinance Declaring Emergency pursuant to the City's Home Rule authority under Texas Health and Safety Code, Section 122.006 and providing for rules thereunder.

Council Member Huffman moved to approve Ordinance 1292 as amended to strike out Sections 6 & 7 and a correction to have the Ordinance run until April 7, 2020. Seconded by Council Member Davis.

Council Member May moved to amend the Ordinance as motioned to run until April 30, 2020, seconded by Council Member Sutton.

The motion failed with a 2-3 vote with Council Members May and Sutton voting "aye" and Council Members Huffman, Garza, and Davis voting "nay".

The original motion was called.

All Council Members voted “aye” and none “nay”. Motion passed with a 5 – 0 vote.

5. Adjournment

There being no further business, the Mayor adjourned the meeting at 7:27 p.m.
