Sunday, March 29, 2020

Beginning Monday, March 30th and running until Saturday, April 4th, the United States Air Force will be conducting pre-deployment training in order to meet readiness requirements for the 9th Air Support Operations Squadron and the 457th Fighter Squadron pilots (flying F16s). The pre-deployment training will occur next week, beginning at 9 a.m. each morning and concluding by 5 p.m. each evening.

Personnel from the 9th ASOS conducting this training will work within their bounds to mitigate risk as much as possible due to ongoing COVID-19 concerns and want to communicate with the citizens of McCulloch and San Saba counties that there is no reason to be concerned about their presence in the communities during the week. Training will primarily be conducted from government operated vehicles to minimize and interaction with residents.

Again, residents should not be concerned about any military presence seen in the community for the next week as it is just pre-deployment training requirements for the US Military.
